**York Minster Neighbourhood Plan** Last May, York Minster launched a public consultation on the future development and use of the buildings and land within the Minster Precinct. The feedback has been used to develop and refine proposals which were published on Friday 17 May for public consultation. The consultation exhibition is available to view in the North Transept and online ([yorkminster.org/about-us/master-planning](http://yorkminster.org/about-us/master-planning)) until 13 June 2019. **Appointment of a new Archbishop of York** The Vacancy-in-See Committee is the group of people tasked with recommending to HM the Queen names of people who Might be appointed as our new Archbishop. This committee is consulting widely to find out what others in the Province think. Our Community Committee has already had a discussion based on questions the Vacancy-in-See Committee has provided. We want to involve as many people as possible in providing feedback for the Vacancy-in-See Committee. We have put three dates in the diary for consultation meetings: Sunday 9 June 11.30 am – 12.30 pm in the Chapter House; Wednesday 12 June 7.30 pm – 8.30 pm in Church House, and Thursday 13 June 12.00 pm – 1.00 pm in Church House. There is also a meeting 17 June, from 7.30 pm at the Belfrey Hall, Stonegate, YO1 8AS. Anyone is welcome to attend any of these meetings. Feedback will be sent on to the Committee. Come and have your say and please start using this prayer regularly.

**Tickets go on sale for *Northern Lights*** Tickets are now on sale for *Northern Lights* sound and light installation, taking place in October this year. The installation will transform the Cathedral's Nave, and immerse viewers in images and audio inspired by the Minster's stained glass and stone. They will raise funds to support the 20-year campaign to ensure all 128 of the Minster's stained glass windows have external glazing to protect them from the elements. Opening on Thursday 24 October, the installation will run for eight nights, with two performances each evening at 7.00 pm and 9.00 pm. Tickets cost £6 in advance, £8 on the door, and are available at [www.yorkminster.org](http://www.yorkminster.org), by calling 01904 557256 or at the cathedral's admission desks.

**The Minster Community Committee** met on 15 May. We agreed updates on our Constitution, and received reports from each of our sub-groups. Developments were made in the formation of a new sub-group which focuses on church growth and discipleship. Plans were made for the AGM on Wednesday 5 June, and there was a lengthy discussion around the questions given by the Vacancy in See Committee, which will be further explored in sessions arranged by Canon Michael for the Minster Community.

**A new guidebook** For the first time in seven years, the Minster has a brand new 64 page guidebook, completely revised with engaging and well-written text, spectacular new photography and an introduction from Dean Jonathan. The cover price, £6.00, is still the same. Commissioned by a team from the Minster including Canon Collingwood, this guidebook has been 18 months in the preparation and was launched at the Community AGM on 5 June.
