In 2007, the Church of England commissioned the 'Past Cases Review' of the handling by the church of child protection cases over many years.

All dioceses and cathedrals have now been asked to re-examine and extend the review (PCR2).

The House of Bishops wants to ensure that our churches and church-related activities are as safe as possible for children and vulnerable adults.
