Changes to end of services Traditionally the end of a service is an opportunity to meet and chat together, but the current circumstances mean that we simply cannot do this in person. This is difficult for all of us, but for the safety of everyone, and to comply with Government guidelines, we are asking congregations to leave promptly at the end of services, as guided by our stewards.

To help with this, exit from the 11.00 am Eucharist, and from Evensong, will now be via the North West door until further notice.

Clergy remain available for pastoral conversation at other times, and contact details are in this notice sheet. There is also an opportunity to meet together on zoom, after the 10.00 am Eucharist online, for virtual coffee.

Face coverings are now mandatory for all those attending a place of worship (unless you are exempt), including ministers, worshippers, staff, volunteers, contractors and visitors, where there may be other people present; remembering that they are mainly intended to protect other people, not the wearer, from coronavirus COVID-19 and that they are not a replacement for physical distancing and regular hand washing. *In order not to impair audibility during public worship, clergy will remove masks to speak and lead prayers but will wear masks at all other times: those who are administering holy communion will wear a mask during the time of administration.*

Please be aware that York Minster is now required to ask for your name and a contact telephone number or e-mail when you attend for worship. This will only be used if we are required to contact you due to the Test & Trace programme. Please bring a piece of paper or card with your contact details on it with you and put it in the box provided at the entrance. We will hold this information securely and will destroy it after 21 days.

Enthronement of the Archbishop of York The Most Reverend Stephen Cottrell, will be enthroned as the 98th Archbishop of York at a simple service of Evensong at 4.00 pm this Sunday, 18 October at York Minster. The Enthronement will take place on the Feast day of St Luke, Apostle and Evangelist. This is a ticketed service and will be held under careful Government and Church of England Covid19 secure guidelines, with strict limits on the numbers attending. The service will be live-streamed from <https://www.facebook.com/thechurchofengland/> making it possible for communities across the Diocese of York, the Northern Province and the worldwide household of the Christian Church to experience the occasion in real time.

Sad News I am sorry to let you know that two members of our community have died recently. Reverend Frank Chappell died on Wednesday 7th October aged 83. Frank has been worshipping here for a number of years with his wife Gail and he was also one of our Honorary Chaplains. His funeral is here on Friday 23rd October and in line with present regulations only 30 people will be able to attend so, if you have

not been specifically invited by his family, I am afraid you will not be able to attend the service. Terry Fowler died on Wednesday 13th October aged 91. She has been a regular worshipper here for many years and she has also been a very active member of the Friends of York Minster. Her funeral is on Wednesday 4th November and, sadly, the same restrictions apply.
