The St Cuthbert Window in the South Quire Aisle will be removed in Spring 2021 for a programme of conservation lasting 3-5 years. An exhibition 'Light, Glass & Stone: Conserving the St Cuthbert Window' will open in June 2021 and run for the duration of the project. Situated in the South Quire Aisle, it will explore three main themes: the creation of the window in the mid-15th century, the life of St Cuthbert, and the conservation of the window (west end).
